## PES Board Resolution No. 1 Series of 2018

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees (BOT) officers are mandated to set the policies and manage the activities and finances of the PES under the By-laws;

WHEREAS, the officers must be willing to devote their time, share their knowledge and experience, and mobilize their linkages to advance the goals of PES;

WHEREAS, there is a need to clarify the nomination process to ensure that prospective members of the BOT are willing and able to fulfill their duties if they get elected to the Board:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved that the PES Board shall adopt the following guidelines for the nomination process of prospective members of the BOT:

- (i) Candidates must be lifetime members of PES at the time of their nomination;
- (ii) Candidates must have been nominated or endorsed by any active member of the PES;
- (iii) Incumbent members of the BOT whose terms are expiring are automatically nominated unless they decline the nomination.
- (iv) Self-nomination is strictly prohibited.
